The beautiful Kronborg with in the background seen By the Ocean we Unite's charter **FANTASTIKO** , which sailing vessel is a beautiful 26-meter long two-masted ketch. and is perfectly suited for sea sailing expeditions! the ship is used for all **by the Ocean we Unite** major expeditions. The vessel was built at a specialized shipyard, **Chinook** in Haarlem, the Netherlands. The construction, from 2002 till 2012, was carried out as a Youth Care project of the province of North-Holland. Two hundred youngsters build the ship together with dozens of experts. The **FANTASTIKO** received a Register



Holland quality label. The fully equipped ship offers room for 15 persons. **By the Ocean we Unite** charters sea sailing ship "FANTASTIKO" including professional crew for every expedition. At present the FANTASTIKO is still in Copenhagen and will depart soon heading back to Rotterdam with the following scheduled stops :

- Marstal** (Denmark) – Thursday **August 16**
  - Kiel** (Germany) – Friday & Saturday **August 17 & 18**
  - Texel** (the Netherlands) – Tuesday **August 21**
  - Rotterdam** (the Netherlands) – Wednesday **August 22**
- Arrival @ harbor: 10am (planned)**

The experienced and enthusiastic crew runs an extensive program on



sailing, the marine environment and of course, plastic. Participants can immerse themselves in lectures, discussions, workshop. They are invited to actively help conducting our research.

## US containerised imports setting records as shippers try to beat tariff wall

CONTAINERISED imports arriving at major US ports have set two new records this summer and are expected to set another this month in August according to the monthly Global Port Tracker from the National Retail Federation (NRF) and Hackett Associates. NRF is forecasting that total 2018 sales will be up between 3.8 per cent and 4.4 per cent over 2017.
